THREADWORMS

We would like to make parents aware that there has been a case of threadworms in school this week. Please can we ask parents to keep an eye on their own children, and treat if necessary. Strict hygiene measures can help clear up a threadworm infection and reduce the likelihood of reinfection – Children should wash their hands regularly and scrub under their fingernails, particularly after going to the toilet and before mealtimes.
