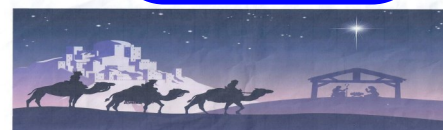
We'd like your help by playing face and object recognition games with your child, within a 2-week period over the holiday.
