

## DEVON SPRING 2018 JUNIOR OPEN

**ENTRY FEE £12.00**

-  **PLAY will start at 9.30am.** Please arrive in good time. The day will finish after the prize giving; this will be as soon as possible after the last round finishes – at about 5.15pm or earlier.
